About Winnipeg

The University of Manitoba is located in the city of Winnipeg, in the province of Manitoba, Canada. Winnipeg is located in the geographical centre of North America. It is approximately 90 minutes from the United States/Canada border, the longest unprotected border in the world. The Winnipeg International Airport, Canada's only centrally-located facility, is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Winnipeg is located some 148 miles north of Grand Forks, ND, 1300 km west from Calgary, 1350km from Edmonton. Winnipeg is easily reached by Highways 1 (TransCanada), and by Interstate 29/Highway 75 from Grand Forks, ND.

Throughout Winnipeg, a proud, rich history and a high quality of life are quite apparent (it's also the home of Winnie the Pooh!). A neighbouring university, the University of Winnipeg, is located in downtown Winnipeg. The University of Manitoba is host to 6 sororities and fraternities: Alpha Delta Pi, Alpha Gamma Delta, Alpha Phi, Delta Upsilon, Phi Delta Theta, and Zeta Psi.
